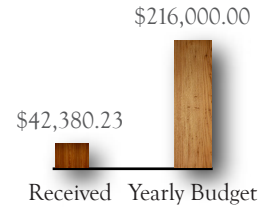
CHURCH BUDGET | YEARLY



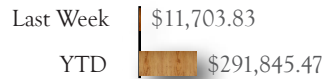

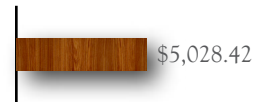
