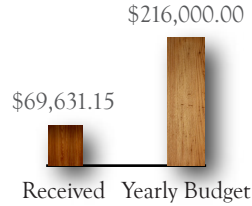
CHURCH BUDGET | YEARLY



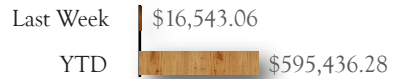
