Roasted Brussels Sprouts

"This recipe is from my mother. It may sound strange, but these are really good and very easy to make. The Brussels sprouts should be brown with a bit of black on the outside when done. Any leftovers can be reheated or even just eaten cold from the fridge. I don't know how, but they taste sweet and salty at the same time!"

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 pounds Brussels sprouts, ends trimmed and yellow leaves removed
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (205 degrees C).
2. Place trimmed Brussels sprouts, olive oil, kosher salt, and pepper in a large resealable plastic bag. Seal tightly, and shake to coat. Pour onto a baking sheet, and place on center oven rack.
3. Roast in the preheated oven for 30 to 45 minutes, shaking pan every 5 to 7 minutes for even browning. Reduce heat when necessary to prevent burning. Brussels sprouts should be darkest brown, almost black, when done. Adjust seasoning with kosher salt, if necessary. Serve immediately.

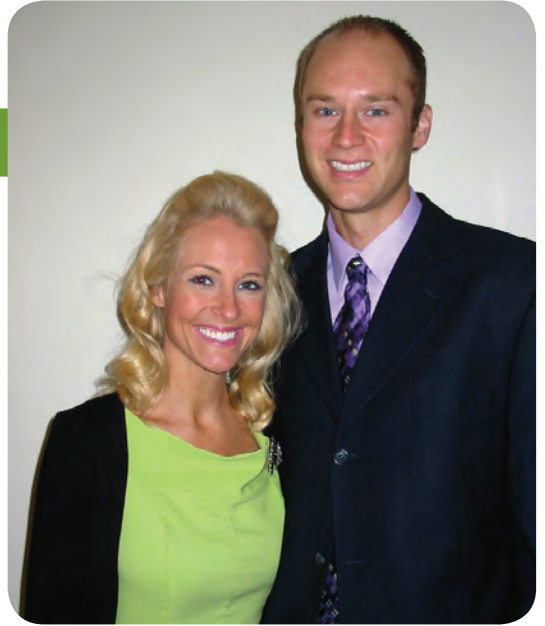

In Remembrance: Carlos Parman

Carlos Parman passed away on October 29, 2011 in his home.

Carlos Marion Parman was born October 26, 1928 in Evansville, Indiana on a farm. He was the 4th of 5 children born to George and Nina Parman. In 1946 he joined the Army Air Corp, specializing in Radar Technology. He was honorably discharged in July, 1949. He decided to attend Southern Missionary College (now Southern Adventist University) taking theology. After a year of study he decided that was not for him. Instead he studied Physical Therapy, earning a B.S. degree from St. Louis University in Missouri. Carlos met the love of his life, Laura Belle Self, while attending college. They were married on June 3, 1951. After finishing college Carlos moved his family to Boulder, Colorado. While there their first daughter, Sandra, was born. In the fall of 1958 Carlos took a position at the Children's Hospital in Knoxville, Tennessee where their daughter Debra was born. Next came a boy, Terre, and their family was complete. They moved to Hinsdale, Illinois where Carlos took over as head of the Physical Therapy Department at Hinsdale Sanitarium and Hospital. In 1970 they moved to Fletcher, North Carolina. Carlos also worked as a Physical Therapist in Ellijay, Georgia, Portland, Tennessee and ended his career in Madison, Tennessee. He retired in 1993 and shortly thereafter he and Laura moved to Calhoun, Georgia to be near family.

Carlos liked to help wherever he could and for many years, until his health prevented it, he would faithfully come to the church office each week and fold the church bulletins. He also loved to read and checked out many books in the church library during that time.

Carlos loved the beauty of the plants, animals and birds and taught his children and grandchildren to love nature as much as he did. He especially loved bird watching. Carlos had the ability to see the gifts and blessings that so many take for granted. If there was one word that could describe Carlos Parman, it would be "faithful." He was faithful to God, his wife, his family and his country.

Carlos is survived by one son, Terre Parman and his wife, Lanette of Lakewood, Washington; two daughters, Sandy Parman and Debra Parman both of Calhoun; one brother, Bill Parman; and one sister, Wanda Gilly both of Evansville, Indiana; and four grandchildren. Funeral services were conducted at Calhoun Seventh-day Adventist Church on November 1 with Pastor Robert Self, Pastor Dave Smith, and Pastor Ken Mittleider officiating. Interment was at Gordon Memorial Gardens with full military rites.

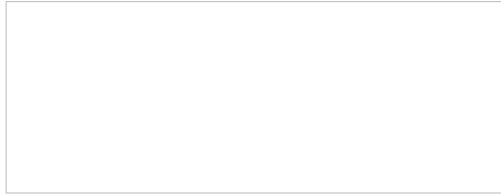
