

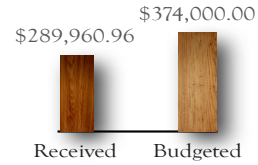

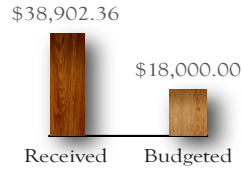

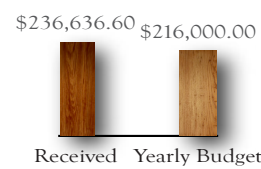
CHURCH BUDGET | YEARLY
